
What is a SMALL MOMENT story?

- It's about one thing (focus)
- A true story about ourselves
- It's about things people do
- Events of the story are told in order



As writers, the kindergarten students are recalling true events from their own lives. We are "telling" these stories aloud, sharing with partners & with the whole class. You can help at home by talking with your child about special moments, family vacations, birthdays, outings and adventures, and special memories you've shared together.

After reading about tooth brushing & healthy eating habits, I asked the class a survey question: How many teeth have you lost?

We collected data on our Tooth Tally Chart & then colored in a graph.

Finally each student shared a "tooth story" and wrote about it in their writing notebook. Their stories were really cute! Some students wrote about going to the dentist & others wrote about a time when he/she lost a tooth.

Our Family Fun Reading Night is Thursday, March 26th.


5:30-8:00 p.m.
