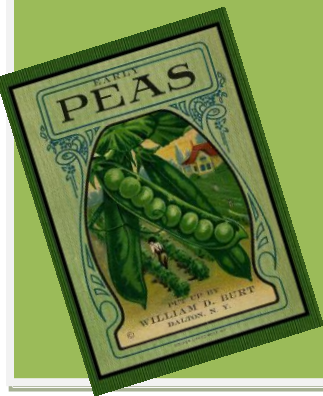
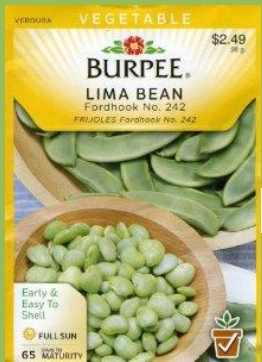
Plants
