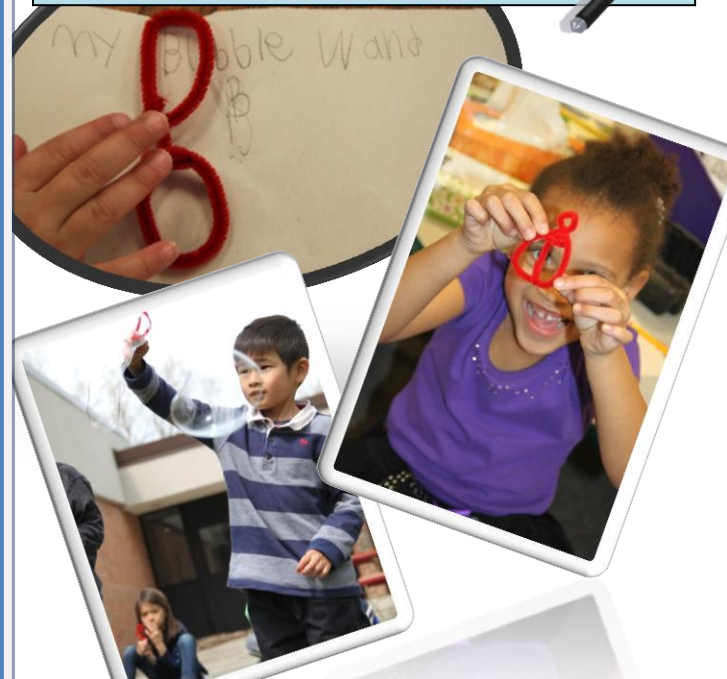

We are learning about
the properties of air.

S.T.E.A.M. Focus Activity
(Science Technology Engineering Art & Mathematics)

On Thursday, last week, each student designed and created a bubble wand using one pipe cleaner.

First, we watched a short video clip, with several examples of objects that used air (hot air balloons, balloons, bounce houses, and bubbles). The video is linked to our class site.

Next, I blew some bubbles using a bubble wand. The students were very excited & of course wanted to make their own.

Then, I proposed the challenge of creating a bubble wand using a pipe cleaner. Each student was responsible for drawing a blueprint, for the plan and design of their bubble wand.

Upon finalizing their blueprint, each student received a pipe cleaner to build the bubble wand.

Finally, we went outside and tested the bubble wands. Each student was able to reflect & modify their design if necessary. The last step was to write about the experience.
