The RAZ-KIDS login information is for your reference & use at home (the little green paper that was clipped into your child's blue folder). Each child has a unique password assigned by me. I've stressed the importance of keeping passwords private & the student login is important to track his/her progress.

Please note that your child's "symbol" may have changed. This is not significant. I was able to reset all of their passwords as I originally set them up.

Upper Case & Lower Case


Blankets & Snacks

MATH



We are looking closely at shapes to discover the lines and corners and correctly name the following two-dimensional shapes:


triangle, square, rectangle, hexagon, rhombus, and circle

In the classroom we are using pattern blocks & attribute blocks to sort & classify shapes into categories. We are looking for common properties & learning to use our "math words" (mathematical language) to speak about & classify shapes.

Look around your house for examples of squares and rectangles. How are they alike? How are they different?

We are looking for rectangles that have "2 long sides" and "2 short sides". Squares must have all 4 sides the same length.

What shapes do you see around the house or out and about?

READING

The little paper books that come home are great for your child to practice pointing & matching to the text.

Making a one-to-one match with text is important. Your child will begin to notice that each word on the page is followed by "space". There is "space" between words.

Have your child point & match as you read together. If your child is having difficulty have him/her hold on to your finger as you point & match. Or... hold his/her pointed finger & help move the hand along as you match your reading voice with the text.
